

Passenger flights (in thousands)




Cargo flights (in thousands)




General aviation, business flights & others (in thousands)




Market share of different traffic types









## Number of movements per hour


Average on a yearly basis









## Map of Brussels Airport







Number of passengers travelling by train to/from Brussels Airport










Number of seized false or forged passports




